All Site Applications will be received and considered against a selection criterion based on past performance, value for money, and the ability to obtain and entice attraction through means of interactive materials or displays. The purpose of encouraging interactive material is to ensure all trade-sites have equal opportunity to particulate in our 'Interactive Trail'- fun for both the children participating, and a great form of advertisement.

Some ideas of interactive merchandise are- balloons, pens, notebooks, testers of your items, magnets etc.

You could create an Instagram Frame, Photo Wall, Lego Pit, Games, or demonstration of equipment.

A Certificate of Currency for Public Liability must accompany this application.

**APPLICATIONS WITHOUT PUBLIC LIABILITY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

It is necessary that all electrical cords and electrical equipment used on the Goondiwindi Showground be tested and tagged as per legislation.

NO applications will be accepted after Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2024.



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**Stall Set Up** – Trade Sites are to be set up on Thursday the 2nd of May from 9.00am – 6.00pm or on an alternative day through prior arrangement with the office and trade steward.

- Upon arriving at the grounds stall holders are to register at the office.
- Should you require a set up on Friday please arrange this with the show society prior to the event. If this is being requested, please note that no vehicle access will be permitted once the General Patrons Gate is open and thoroughfare becomes a pedestrian zone only.

The Secretaries office will open at 8.30am during the week leading up to the show.

**Opening Times** – Pavilions open at 10.00am- your stall will need to be completely set up no later than this time.

Pavilions close at 6pm, vendors are not permitted to begin deconstruction of stalls before the closure. If you choose to stay open later than 6pm, this is acceptable and encouraged.

**Stall Pack Up** – It is preferred that Trade Sites pack up on Sunday the 5<sup>th</sup> of May, however, pack up on Saturday night is an option.

**NO** vehicles are permitted within the Show Grounds on Saturday night due to the large number of patrons arriving for the Saturday night entertainment. Contact the office or trade steward to request assistance via the society's buggy or trolleys. Alternatively, you can choose to Pack Down on Sunday from 7am and have full access to the Pavilion with your vehicle.

**Hospitality Packages** are strictly available from 'The Wilga'.

No food, soft drink, alcohol is permitted to be bought onto the Show Grounds, as this is in direct violation with our Liquor Licensing. Please order Food and Alcohol through the Bar Stewards.

**Payments** – Please note payments must be made prior to the commencement of the show. Direct Debit details will be provided on tax invoices. Note: Goondiwindi Show Society is now cashless and will only accept eftpos or direct debit.

**Cancellations** – Please note cancellations must be made a full 72hrs prior to the commencement of the show, failure to cancel prior to this 72hr period will result in forfeit of entire site fees already paid. Direct Debit details will be provided on tax invoices.

Please submit your application as soon as possible with **FULL** details, but please **DO NOT** send money until you receive confirmation that your application is successful, and a Tax Invoice has been issued by the Society.

Site Applications received after April the 1st, 2024 **WILL NOT** be accepted.

Trade Passes Should your application be accepted; your site will be issued with two (2) trade passes for entry into the show. These will be issued through our online ticket system once your payment has been received.

Passes will be emailed out to your nominated email address. Should you not have your pass with you upon arriving on the day of the event you will be requested to pay entry to the show – If this is to occur there is **STRICTLY NO REFUNDS FOR ENTRY.**
