- The "Show Period" includes Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.
- Camping Fees: No charge for the Show Period.
- Stable fees: \$20 per stable for the Show Period. Yards no charge / no prior bookings taken.
- Stable Bookings Strictly Online https://www.goondiwindishow.com.au/stabling
- Stable Cancellation: Stables are Non-Refundable if cancelled less than 72hrs from commencement of event
- Stable fees outside the "Show Period" \$10 per stable per night, for the first night and \$5
- per stable per night each night following.
- Camping fees outside the "Show Period" Powered site -\$28 per night. Non powered site \$20 per night. Camping and Stabling Fees apply for competitors arriving prior to the Show Period.
- Horse Health Declarations and Indemnity Forms are to be submitted to the office on arrival to the grounds. Wristbands will be given to all competitors.
- Tickets for the Show Jumping, Sporting and Ring Events will be available for purchase via <u>EFTPOS</u> or CHEQUE only from Friday 7am 3pm and Saturday 7am 3pm. Strictly no cash accepted.
- Ring & Sporting Ticket Refunds: All Showjump, Ring and Sporting Event tickets are refundable
 via <u>direct debit only</u>, a request for refund must be lodged at the Ring Ticket Office by 3:00pm on
 the day
 - of competition. Payments will be made into the nominated account within 48hours of completion of show.
- Horses placed in the incorrect stables will be moved by the P&A committee to the cattle yards. It
 will then be the owner's responsibility to move them to the correct stables.
- Stables must be left clean with manure placed in mounds at end of each row of stables.
- Ring events to be conducted under Queensland Ag Shows Rules, unless otherwise specified within the program.
- No ribbons other than those won at the Society's current show are to be worn or displayed.

- No competitor will be judged unless he or she hands a TICKET to the Ring Steward.
- DISTRICT EVENTS: A horse and rider to be resident for 3 months within the Goondiwindi Regional Council or 60km from Goondiwindi Post Office into New South Wales or a Goondiwindi Pony Club Member
- LOCAL CLASSES SHOW HUNTER & SHOW HACKS: Show Hunters & Show Hacks are combined in Local Classes.
- CHILDREN'S DISTRICT EVENTS. It is optional to wear Pony Club uniform or a Riding Coat.
- Children must WEAR APPROVED HELMETS
- Short Boots are to be worn by Adults and Juveniles riding in Pony Hack and Hunter Hack classes 12.2 hand and under 14 hands.
- Any horse of doubtful height will be asked to be measured by the Official Measurer.
- MAIDEN, NOVICE, OPEN: A MAIDEN has not won in competition at an affiliated agricultural Show. After winning a MAIDEN Hack or Hunter Hack class this horse will be recognised as a NOVICE. A Novice will remain a NOVICE until winning an open championship as either a Hack or Hunter Hack at an affiliated agricultural show.
- HEIGHT: Queensland Ag Shows rules apply. Life Measurements will only be accepted if the horse
 is over 7 years of age. Current EA or Show Horse Council certificates run from January 1 and
 expire last week in December of that year and will be accepted if in correct date range and
 official certificate produced and has been issued at an official measuring day. If there is any
 dispute the official measurement on the ground will overrule and apply. Two measurements
 only will be accepted each within ten minutes of each other.
- AGES: Male horses under the age of four (4) years are defined as being Colts and female horses under the age of four (4) years are defined as being Fillies.
- A **Galloway Hack** shall be over 14 hands and must not exceed 15 hands.
- All Pony Hacks and Hunter Pony Hacks 12.2hh and under to be ridden by a rider under 17 years of age.
- Horses may be entered in Hack classes OR Hunter Hack classes but not in both. (With the exception
 of Local classes where Show Hunters & Show Hacks are combined)
- Stallions: At no time can a stallion be handled by a person under eighteen (18) years of age.
- Exhibitors to present official breed cards upon request by stewards at the Show.
- SAFETY: CHIEF STEWARD MAY AT ANY TIME REQUIRE A PERSON WHO DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE ABLE TO RIDE OR HANDLE ANY HORSE/PONY TO DISMOUNT AND HAS THE RIGHT TO REMOVE COMPETITOR
 - FROM RING FOR SAFETY REASONS.
- No exhibitor shall engage or be knowingly involved in cruelty to a horse. Ring Committee will be sole judges of what constitutes cruelty but may include excessive use of whip, spurs or bit, electric shock,
 - exhausted or lame, inadequate food or drink, excessive exercise.
- RING PROGRAMME WILL NOT BE HELD UP IN THE CASE OF EVENTS CLASHING. COMPETITORS
 MUST DECIDE.
- Competitors must ensure they have complied with all tick and movement requirements https://www.business.qld.gov.au/industries/farms-fishing-forestry/agriculture/animal/move/tick-zones/regulations
- All dogs whilst on the showground must be on a lead.
- No electric fences are to be used at Goondiwindi P&A Events.
