**WOOL ENTRY FORMS AVAILABLE AT WOOL PAVILION  
EACH ENTRY MUST BE CLEARLY LABELLED**

**NO ENTRY FEE**

Entries will be received in the Wool Pavilion on Monday 29th April between 9am and 3pm and Tuesday the 30th April between 8am and 4pm.

All fleeces must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor.

Fleeces must be skirted and contain no bellies, locks or stained wool. It must be shorn from sheep run under normal paddock conditions with exception of Housed Stud sheep. The judge will decide on whether the wool has been Housed or not.

Each fleece will be eligible for one class only, but the best fleece in any section will be considered for championship purposes.

All exhibitors are required to state their wishes regarding disposal of their wool after the show. Wool will be judged on a points system.

Micron testing will be conducted to differentiate the classes. Pet fleeces are eligible for Class 40 only.

1st, 2nd and 3rd Society prize ribbons in all classes. Ribbons for Champion and Reserve Champion.

Trophies and prize money where indicated.

No trophies will be awarded unless there are three or more entries in each section.
