The Cracknell Shield for aggregate points for articles.

1st - \$100, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20.

The Jubilee Trophy for Overall Appearance of "Creative Window",

1st - \$100, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20.

"Creative Window" size (for exhibits) are approximately 2.47m wide, 0.92m front to back, 1.22m height at front, 1.09m height at back.

The theme for this year's Show is "CHRISTMAS".

A competitive display to comprise ten (10) articles. All articles must be the bonafide work of a member of the group concerned.

All articles must only be shown for one year in display. Articles may have been entered in the Open Section of the previous Show.

Any machine or handmade article should not have been worn or laundered.

1. Each "Creative Window" to include ten (10) articles, of which the following crafts could be featured; Floral Work, Cookery, Art, Basketry, Folk Art, China Painting, Knitting, Leatherwork, Paper Making, Textiles, Paper Mache, Stained Glass, Ceramics, Crochet, Patchwork, Jewellery, Toy Making, Sewing, Embroidery, Wool Work, Decoupage, Tapestry, Smocking, Millinery or any other craft.
2. Other props and backdrops may be included to enhance the appearance of "Creative Window".
3. The articles for display are to represent the chosen theme.
4. A piece of white cardboard 20 x 25cm or A4 to be provided by each group showing number of article, name of maker, name of craft and number of different crafts displayed. Each article is to have its own separate decorated small card showing name of maker and craft.
5. To encourage a wider variety of crafts, one point is to be awarded for each separate craft in display, e.g. 10 separate crafts = 10 points, 9 different crafts = 9 points etc.
6. The maximum points possible is 10 points per article – ½ points allowed.
7. The Cracknell Shield to be awarded to the group gaining the highest number of points for the 10 individual articles in the "Creative Window".
8. The Jubilee Tray donated by Kindon CWA awarded to the group winning the overall appearance of the "Creative Window".

9. For the best individual Articles in the "Creative Window" the following prizes will be awarded:
 - a. Trophy donated by Shirley Carrigan for the Best Individual Article.
 - b. Trophy donated by Mrs. Jocelyn Cameron, Lapunyah, Goondiwindi for the individual article placed second.
 - c. Mrs. C McClymont Memorial Trophy, donated by Di Selby for the individual article placed third.

N.B. All "Creative Windows" to be erected Wednesday, 1st May, 2019. Judging will take place, Thursday, 2nd May 2019 at 9:00am sharp and before the judging of individual articles.

Representatives of groups participating will be allowed in the pavilion after 6:15pm Saturday, 4th May, to dismantle display.

The P & A Ladies Auxiliary is also quite happy for groups to dismantle entries after the completion of the Show, i.e. the following day or during the following week.

On completion of the Show all articles are the responsibility of the group (groups) involved.
