Dress Code: All exhibitors are to wear jeans and a country shirt or a shirt bearing their stud logo with covered footwear in the Judging ring. School Exhibitors may wear their uniform if preferred. The Chief Steward may disqualify any handler for failing to comply with the dress code.

Junior Judges Competition will be run in conjunction with the Stud Meat Classes, this will be a Queensland Agricultural Shows Qualifier and will therefore follow the Queensland Agricultural Shows Guidelines.

Removal of Stock: 3:00pm or after presentation, whichever is the later.

Passes: All exhibitors are to pay for entry at the gate.

Camping: Free of charge, included in the purchase of entry at the gate.

NLIS: All Sheep regardless of age need to be tagged with a suitable NLIS tag.

Conditions:

1. The show will be run as an accredited brucellosis free show only.
2. Championship sashes will be awarded to Champion Ram and Champion Ewe in each breed. Reserve Champion sashes will be awarded at the Judge's Discretion.
3. Sheep must have been bred in a stud registered in a recognised flock book and must if required by the Breed Society be tattooed with the official tattoo of that Society, signifying that the sheep has been registered or is eligible for registration. Sheep must be entered in the name of the owner.
4. Prior to the commencement of judging, a person nominated by the Goondiwindi P & A Society Steward will inspect rams and ewes of their respective breed for breed types and see that each is tattooed in accordance with the rules of the respective breed society. Any sheep not up to breed standard type and not NLIS ear-tagged will be disqualified. Such sheep will be removed from the precincts of the Show. All sheep entries must comply with the rules of their particular breed societies.
5. All exhibitors must abide by the decisions of the show committee.
6. The Society will provide feed and bedding subject to availability, for a charge.
7. While every precaution will be taken by the Goondiwindi P & A Society Committee to ensure that the sheep comply with the conditions as foresaid, any defects subsequently discovered will be the responsibility and liability, if any, of the exhibitor.
8. In the event of the judge deciding that the exhibit in any class or championship is not worthy of any prize. He shall use his discretion as to what prize, if any, to allot.
9. The Committee will decide any subject not covered by these conditions.
10. Exhibitors from interstate must have 5 ABC points for OJD for entry to Queensland. If a flock is part of the OJD MAP scheme, please advise with your nomination so that suitable penning arrangements can be made.
11. Wool length in Shorn Classes shall not exceed: Short Wools - 12mm. Approximately, 6 weeks off shears; British Breed Long Wools - 38mm. 10 weeks off shears; Polwarth and Corriedale - 38mm. approximately 10 weeks off shears.
12. All sheep must be free of lice and parasites.
13. There will be a Breeder's Group in each section. The groups are to be comprised of three sheep (two ewes and one ram showing no more than four permanent teeth) and are to be bred by the exhibitor. To be drawn from general classes.
14. Sheep may not be entered in more than one class, except for objective measurement, breeders group, and pen and pair classes.
15. For the objective measurement classes the breed standard will be judged by the Stud Meat Sheep Judge. All entries judged together and assessed to their own breed standards.
16. Weighing of all rams and ewe lambs and scanning of rams for Objective measurement Class.
