## Entry Fee: Gold coin donation per exhibitor

**Entries**, will be taken at the Molly Makim Pavilion on Thursday, May 2nd, 2019 between 9:00am and 12:00pm. Judging will commence at 1:00pm on Thursday, May 2nd, 2019. All exhibits are to be the bona fide work of the exhibitor and must not have been laundered. Exhibits must not have been previously exhibited in a Goondiwindi Show. Each exhibit is eligible for competition in one class only. Articles are not to be mounted. In Crochet Classes please attach crochet cotton label (if available). In Knitting Classes please attach yarn label (if available). The Stewards have the right to reject entries for judging.

**Please Note**, that on Saturday May 4th, the Molly Makim Pavilion will close at 5:45pm and reopen at 6:15pm for collection of entries, prize money and trophies.

**N.B.** For garments in 4 ply and thicker use back stitch seams. For 3 ply and finer weave a flat seam. Where wool is not specified any yarn may be used.

The Aggregate Points Trophy will be awarded on a score basis: 5 for 1st, 3 for 2nd and 1 for 3rd.

- Class 1** Article of Baby Clothing.
- Class 2** Article of Child Clothing.
- Class 3** Article of Adult Clothing.
- Class 4** Article by Person Over 75 Years.
- Class 5** Rug, Knee Rug or Cot Cover.
- Class 6** Table Centre or Doily. (a) 20, (b) 40. Size - minimum 20cm & maximum 60cm
- Class 7** Any Article, Cotton 60 or finer.
- Class 8** Article. (a) Unusual, (b) Useful
- Class 9** Any Household Article. eg. edged towel, edged handkerchief, coat hanger, tea cosy, cushion cover.
- Class 10** Article by Person Under 18. (1st - \$10, *donated by Michelle Sehmish-Lahey*)
- Class 11** Tatting.
- Class 12** Tatting by a Novice. (for exhibitors who have not won 1st prize in this class in the last 2 years at the Goondiwindi Show)

## **DIVISION B – KNITTING**

- Class 1** Infant's or Baby's Garment
- Class 2** Child's Cardigan/Pullover
- Class 3** Lady's or Gent's Cardigan/Jumper
- Class 4** Knitted Toy or Novelty, no beads or buttons.
- Class 5** Shawl, Stole, Blanket or Rug.
- Class 6** Men's Knitted Socks.
- Class 7** Article in Wool or Acrylic.
- Class 8** Article by Person Over 75 Years.
- Class 9** Machine Knitted Article.
- Class 10** Article Suitable for a Gift. (excluding garments)
- Class 11** Any Household Article. (eg edged towel, coat hanger, tea cosy, cushion cover)
- Class 12** Any Cotton Article.
- Class 13** Article by Person Under 18. (1st - \$10, *donated by Michelle Sehmish-Lahey*)
- Class 14** Trauma Teddy in Wool or Acrylic, no larger than 30cm high. NOTE: No beads, buttons or loose pieces such as hat or scarf unless they are knitted into the fabric of the teddy. To be donated to Goondiwindi Ambulance Station.

## **DIVISION C – FANCY YARN CLASS**

- Class 1** Any Article either Crocheted, Knitted or Machine Knitted, using fancy yarn. (1st \$60, 2nd \$30 and 3rd \$10, *donated by P & A Women's Auxiliary*)
