CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

1. All entrants must COMPLETE and SIGN the Entry Form. All photos MUST have a Title. Incomplete Entry Forms cannot be processed.
2. All photos must be printed on photographic paper. All photos must have secure matts/ mounting boards (not cardboard) no larger than 11 x 14". All photos, (except Juniors) must be printed either 8 x 10" or 8 x 12". With the exception of Panorama photos which must be no smaller than 10" on the long side and Square photos which must be 8 x 8". Juniors' photos may be 7 x 5" or 6 x 8" with a standard size matt/mounting board. No frames, glass or staples will be accepted. **Photos must NOT BE GLUED to Matts.**
3. Each photo must be clearly marked on the back with Section, Photo Title, Entrant's Name, Address and Sale Price or NFS (prices will not be negotiated on entrant's behalf).
4. All photos must be the original work of the entrant and been taken in the past three years. Photos must not have been previously exhibited in Goondiwindi Show Photography Section.
5. Stewards reserve the right not to hang photos if they do not comply with the Conditions of Entry. No entry fees will be refunded for photos not hung.
6. Stewards reserve the right to move photo/s to a different section, in accordance with subject descriptions provided for each section.
7. All photos selected for Spirit of Goondiwindi Region Acquisition Awards, must be no less than 300dpi saved as a jpeg. Winners must supply a copy of their image to BRCC via email to chamber@goondiwindi.qld.au after the show. Winners must agree for their work to be reproduced for promotional purposes by the sponsors. All winning photos will become sponsor's property. Winners of Spirit of Goondiwindi Acquisition must sign a BRCC Media Release Form prior to receiving their prize. Entrant/s retain copyright of their photo image/s.
8. To be eligible for Discover Farming, all entrants acknowledge and agree Discover Farming may use their images for promotional and marketing purposes, and further agree that any persons featured in images have consented to this for commercial use. Images must be provided in full digital format no less than 300 dpi via email to hello@discoverfarming.com.au prior to judging. The entrant's name will be circulated with the image for acknowledgement of their photography, where practical. The photographer does not have to be a resident of the Goondiwindi Regional Council area. Emails/phone numbers must be provided when entering. The winning photos are acquisitions and remain the property of Discover Farming.
9. Competitors shall allow their work to be reproduced for newspaper, television, website and promotional purposes.
10. Judge's decision will be final. Prizes will be awarded in the form of cash, items or vouchers according to the value shown for each section. Prizes donated in the form of vouchers are NOT transferable to cash. A commission of 15% + GST will be charged for each work sold in all sections.
11. All expenses in conjunction with forwarding, packing, returning and insurance of photos shall be borne by the competitor. The Goondiwindi P&A Society accepts no liability for loss or damage.
