Exhibitors must own sheep from which the wool has been shorn. Fleeces must be skirted and contain no bellies, locks or stained wool.

EACH FLEECE WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR ONE CLASS ONLY, BUT THE BEST FLEECE IN ANY SECTION WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR CHAMPIONSHIP PURPOSES.

Wool will be judged on points system. All fleeces must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor.

Entries will be received in the Wool pavilion on Monday the 29th April, 2019 and Tuesday the 30th of April, 2019 between the hours of 9am - 4pm. Micron testing will be used to differentiate classes.

Pet fleeces are eligible in Class 40 only.

All exhibitors are required to state on their plastic bags or wool cartons, their wishes regarding disposal of wool after the Show.

Wool entered must be shorn from sheep run under normal paddock conditions with exception of shedded Stud sheep.

The judge shall decide on whether wool has been shredded or not.

Awards: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Society prize ribbons in all classes. Sashes for Champions and Reserves. Trophies and Prize money where indicated.

No trophies will be awarded unless there are three or more entries in each division.
