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## GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. Individual competing Schools will select their Own Theme for the Youth Exhibit for 2019.
2. Each School will be allocated a space for their exhibit in the McColl Pavilion. Schools will be notified of the size of their display early in 2019.
3. Displays can be erected in the week prior to the show between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm and must be completed by 5.00pm, Tuesday the 30th of April, 2019.
4. Judging of the displays will take place in the McColl Pavilion on Thursday the 2nd of May, 2019. (No-one will be allowed in the pavilion during judging)
5. Dismantling of exhibits can begin from Sunday 5th May, 2019 9.00am -5.00pm and can happen Monday - Friday by appointment with the Secretary 0437 809 415 or goondiwindishow@bigpond.com
6. All care but no responsibility will be taken with all entries.
7. The Judges' decision is final and no discussion will be entered into.

## COMPETITION CRITERIA

1. A competition display based on the theme chosen by the individual school.
2. Each school can only compete in one division (should your school have a pre-school attached then they exhibit with the nominated school)  
Each exhibit within the overall display will be judged according to age appropriate content
3. All content MUST be created by children
4. Each display MUST include a Display Guide Showing;
  - The School Name
  - Applicable Division
  - The development of the theme
  - An indication of components of the display which had adult input.
  - Which class or level completed each section.

Judges will award points for:

Evidence of the teaching and learning process

Demonstrating the unique quality of the school and school community

Creativity and Innovation

Overall Presentation
